Memphis, TN – April 1, 2008. The United States All-Star Federation and International All-Star Federation (USASF/IASF) are proud to announce The World Championship of All-Star Cheerleading and Dance, the definitive contest where 400 teams and over 40 countries compete for the title of World Champion. The teams will compete in Walt Disney World ®, in Orlando Florida. The championship will last 2 days; April 25-26, 2009.

The title of World Champion will be awarded to each division winner. There are teams competing in USASF Level 5 and 6, and are divided into International, Senior Club, Coed and All Girl divisions. The awarded teams receive a trophy, medallions and championship rings. The title of being the best in the world comes with a large amount of training, commitment and heart for the sport.

The 2009 Cheerleading and Dance Worlds will be the 6th annual championship. The USASF/IASF hosts this event to teams who are sponsored to compete through a “Bid” earned at a qualifying event. Sponsors consist of cheerleading and dance event producers who are sanctioned by the USASF/IASF. Event sanctioning is offered through compliance that identifies the best safety and ethical practices.
