Change in Membership

USASF Announces 1 effective Membership date lower rates for Certified Gyms

Beginning August 1, 2010 the membership period for gyms will run from August 1 of the current year through July 31 of the following year. All members will renew at the same time each calendar year.

For the remainder of the 2009 year through July 31, 2010 current members will participate in the membership rollover program. Memberships that expire during the rollover period will pay a prorated membership that will expire on July 31, 2010. For example, a gym with a December 2009 expiration will renew their membership for the months of January through July (paying \$87.50 for 7 months of membership) and then will renew their annual membership for the period of August 1, 2010 through July 31, 2011.

It is important to note that gyms who do not participate in the USASF Gym Certification program will see an increase in their membership fee. Beginning August 1, 2010 annual membership fees for non-certified gyms will pay \$200 for their annual membership. Certified gyms, however, will not see an increase in their annual membership fee. The membership fee for certified gyms will remain at \$150 for each annual membership period (August 1-July 31).
