<p>Current Rule/Policy:</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;"><i>J. L4 Stunts – Release Moves</i></p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;"><i>1) Release moves are allowed but must not exceed extended arm level (i.e. tick tocks are allowed)</i></p>

<p>New Rule/Suggestion of Change:</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;"><i>Specifically Tick Tocks should not be allowed until Level 5.</i></p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;"><i>Release moves can originate at ground level and finish extended and/or originate at shoulder level or below and finish at shoulder level or below and pas through extended.</i></p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;"><i>Level 5 release moves would then include those that originate and end at shoulder level or above and finish extended</i></p>
