The Cheerleading Worlds

Warm-up Room/Backstage Access Policy

Worlds team rosters must include: all gym owners, coaches, choreographers, trainers, personnel, athletes, and alternate and substitute athletes intending to enter the warm-up room specific to the team preparing to compete.

Cheer Coach credential requirements

- Current USASF Membership
- Current Professional Member (background check and green light status)
- Credentialed through Level 5 in either building, tumbling or both
- Credentialed through Level 6 if coaching a Level 6 team

Athlete membership requirements

- · All athletes must be current members of the USASF and listed on the official Worlds roster.
- Alternate and substitute athletes must meet the age grid criteria for that specific team and each roster is limited to 10 reserve athletes.
- Alternate and substitute athletes must be in uniform and on the roster in order to be allowed in the warm-up/backstage room.
- All U.S.-based athletes must present a photo ID for verification by a USASF official. See page 16.
- Allowed entry into the warm-up room with cleared background check
- · Team parents (limit one parent per nine athletes)

Prohibited from entry into the warm-up room

- · Children not listed on the roster as an athlete or reserve
- VIPs
- Team photographers (also requires USASF media ticket)
- Media (also requires a USASF media ticket)

Event Violation Policy

Failure to produce the proper credentials will prohibit entry into the warm-up room. Unauthorized entry into the warm-up/ backstage area will result in immediate disciplinary action.
